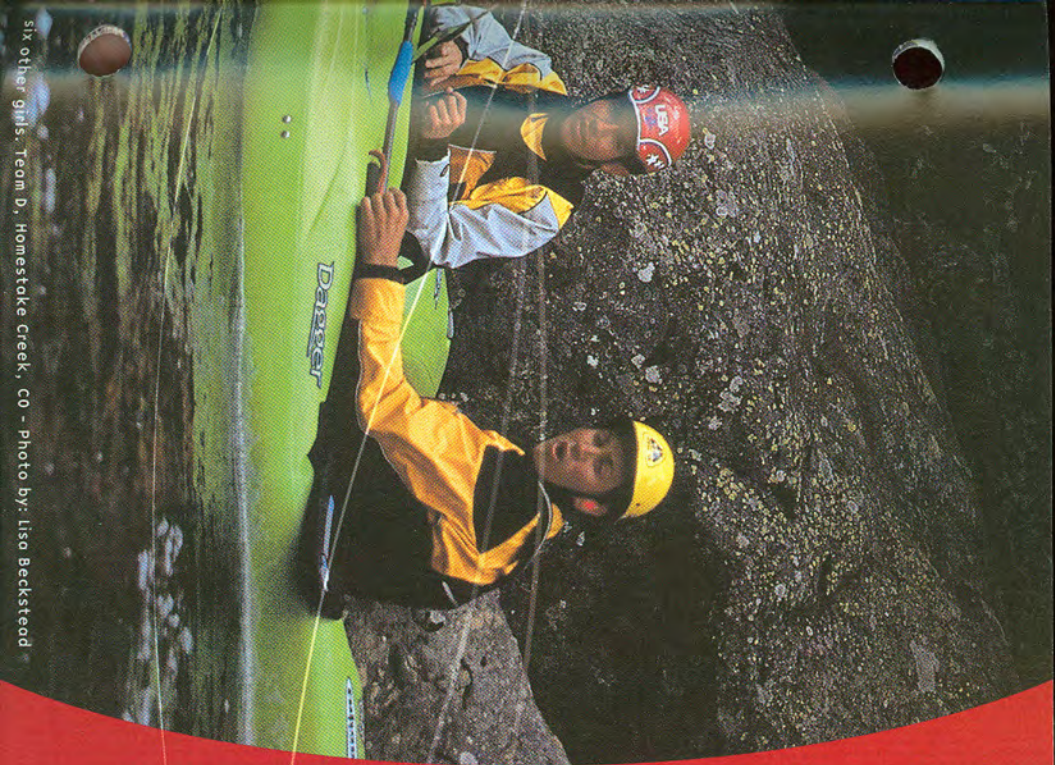
Paddle with the Pros

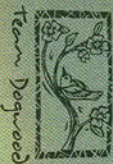
