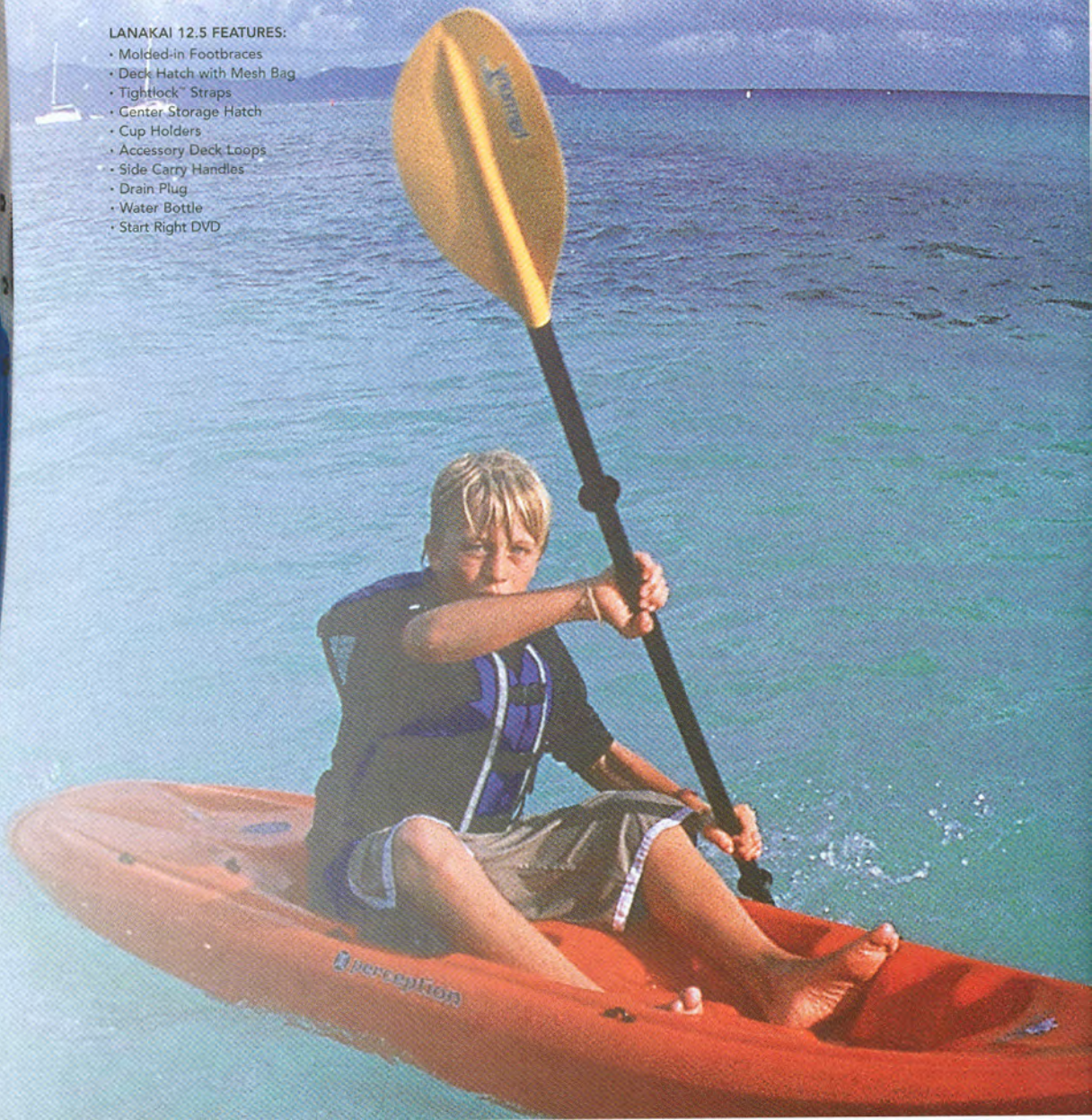

Ketchikan, Alaska


Catching your breath in the beautiful surroundings is harder than catching fish. Thank goodness bears do not like the taste of plastic.

Vancouver Island, British Columbia, Canada

A sit-on-top kayak is a safe and great way to paddle these North Pacific coastlines that are exposed to the roar of the ocean. Remote sunny beaches, dense schools of salmon, challenging whirlpools and a true sense of adventure await you.

Island of Phuket in the Andaman Sea, Thailand

Paddling these waters offers scores of limestone islands filled with hidden lagoons and caves adorned with stalactites. Wildlife, warm waters and the beautiful sand beaches will lure you to stay for a lifetime.

Venice, Italy

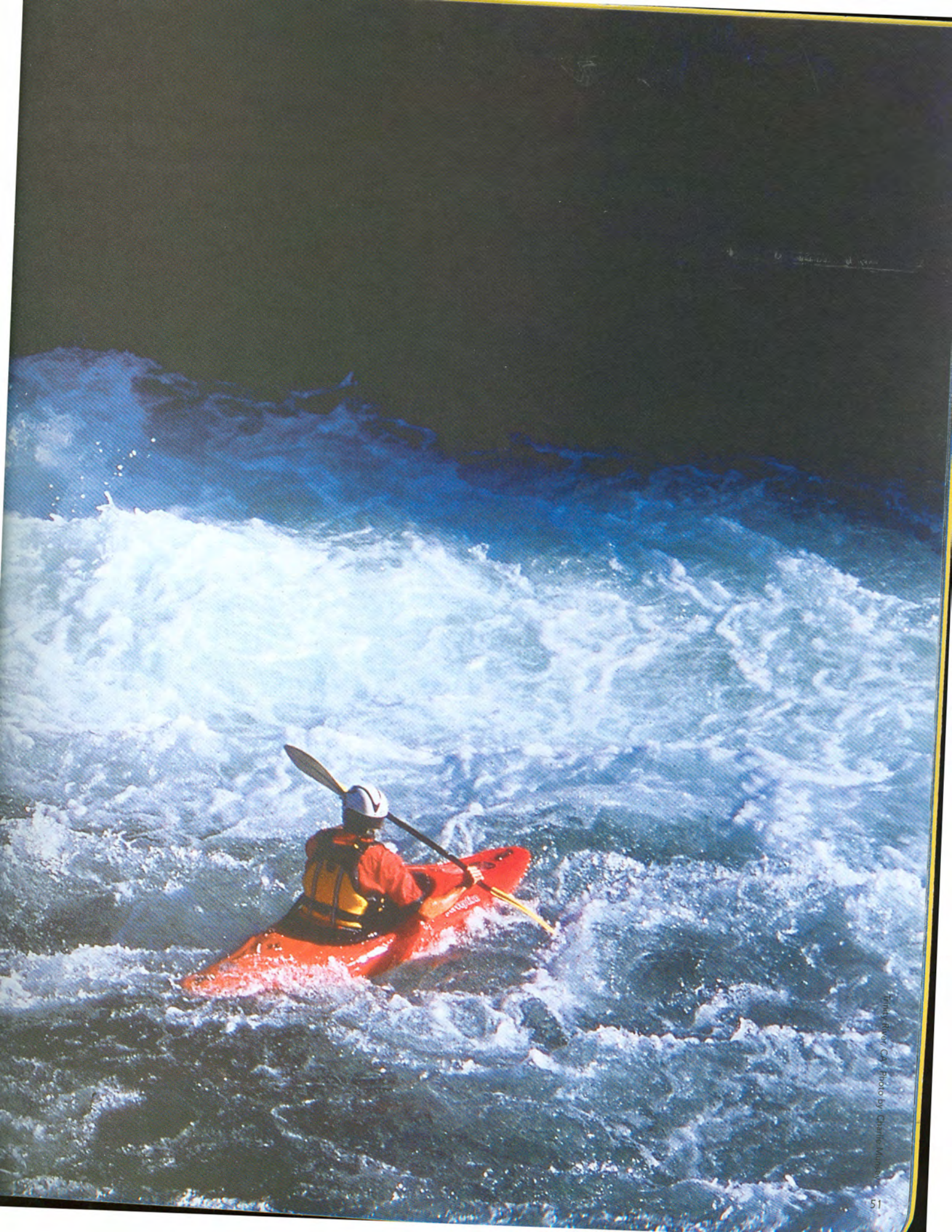

British Columbia, Canada

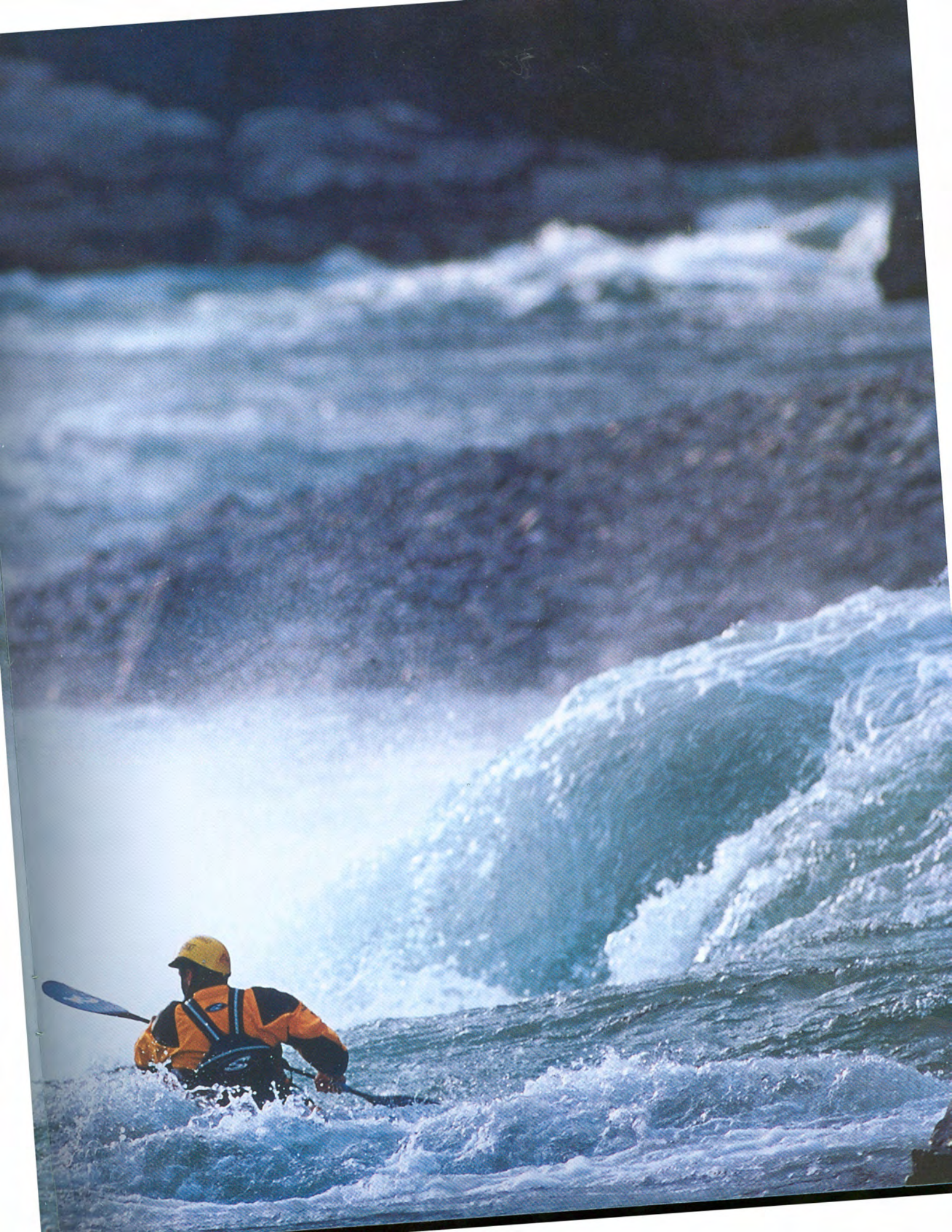
With rivers like the Stikine, Homathko, and Alsek, British Columbia is definitely one of the premier destinations in the world for expedition paddling.

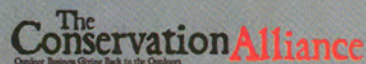
