Quake

The Quake is Dagger's hottest whitewater open canoe and our first rotationally molded canoe. Conforming to the National Organization of Whitewater Redcross specifications, the Quake has molded-in decks, low volume ends for easier initiation and high sides for dryness (if there is such a thing in a hole). Now it's time for the open boaters to flatspin, cartwheel and pull off the freestyle moves only kayak and C-1 paddlers were privy to. Shake it up in the Quake!



Ocoee

The choice of advanced and expert paddlers, the Ocoee is the boat everyone talks about and dreams of paddling. Its flat bottom and hard chines make it one of the most performance-oriented river running canoes available. Hole playing and sliding into those creekly micro-eddies are but a few of the Ocoee's favorite things. Paddling reach is lessened by the dramatic tumblehome below the gunwales, and the deep, flared ends with our unique double gunwale translate into a very dry ride, even when paddled on its namesake. Once you've paddled an Ocoee, it's hard to go back to anything else.



Atom C-1

The Atom continues our proud whitewater canoeing heritage. Following the tradition of the Cascade, which was previously the most recent C-1 design, the Atom is the C-1 for the new millennium. With rockered ends, a flat hull, and hard chines, the Atom is the first C-1 to combine the performance of a slalom boat and the hottest design features of the latest generation of playboats. With a surprisingly stable feel, comfortable minicell outfitting, and our unique Hip Grabber system, the Atom has established itself as the premier C-1 on the river.



Ovation

The Ovation has quickly become our most popular solo whitewater canoe, and with good reason. Its "ghost-chine" at midship provides reliable stability without interfering with hull speed. The flat hull at the center of the boat translates into great surfing and hole riding. With the hard chine above the regular waterline, the Ovation spins well and responds immediately when leaned. Slightly asymmetrical with 5 inches of rocker, this canoe whips hard to catch eddies and peels out dynamically.



Rival

Our lightest-weight whitewater canoe, the Rival was designed by Bob Foote and Steve Scarborough to be fast, nimble, and responsive to the slightest leans and strokes. Needing only gentle pressure to activate the boat, the Rival is especially suited for smaller paddlers. The Rival's deep, asymmetrical hull with a slight stern vee and increased bow rocker provides stability, dryness, and turning agility. Longer than the Ovation with a more aggressive hull design than the Impulse, the Rival is in a class by itself. Whether you are a beginner or expert, the Rival is a canoe you can grow into and never out of.



Impulse

The Impulse is an excellent solo boat for beginners to experienced paddlers who want a predictable, solidly built Royalex canoe. The most stable whitewater canoe that we offer, the Impulse's short length and rocker make it quick turning and maneuverable. Its dependable hull speed and tracking are ideal for those must-make ferries and big water applications. The deep ends and midsection combined with flared stems make this canoe extremely dry in waves, drops, and holes. The easily rollable Impulse allows paddlers of almost any size to show off textbook perfect technique.



Caption

Experienced tandem teams will tell you, the Caption is THE performance oriented tandem whitewater canoe to paddle. Its versatility also allows it to be an awesome solo boat for those single bladed paddlers who prefer a longer canoe. Outfit it with a triple position pedestal and you have two boats in one that will fit your every whitewater mood. The Caption combines a fast hull with soft chines for control, flared ends for dryness, and midship tumblehome for easy reach. Constructed of time-tested Royalex, your Caption will keep you on the river for years to come.

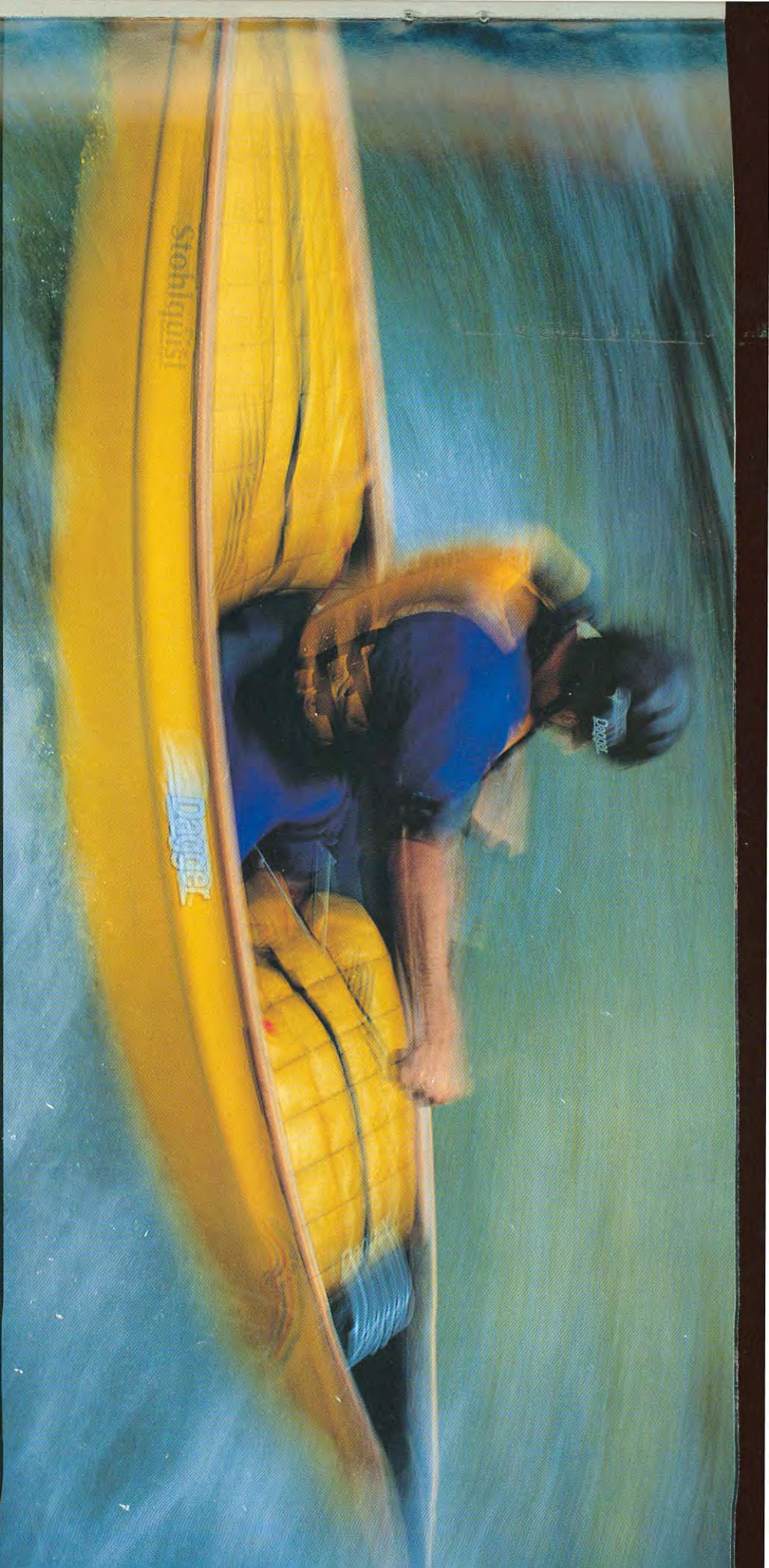

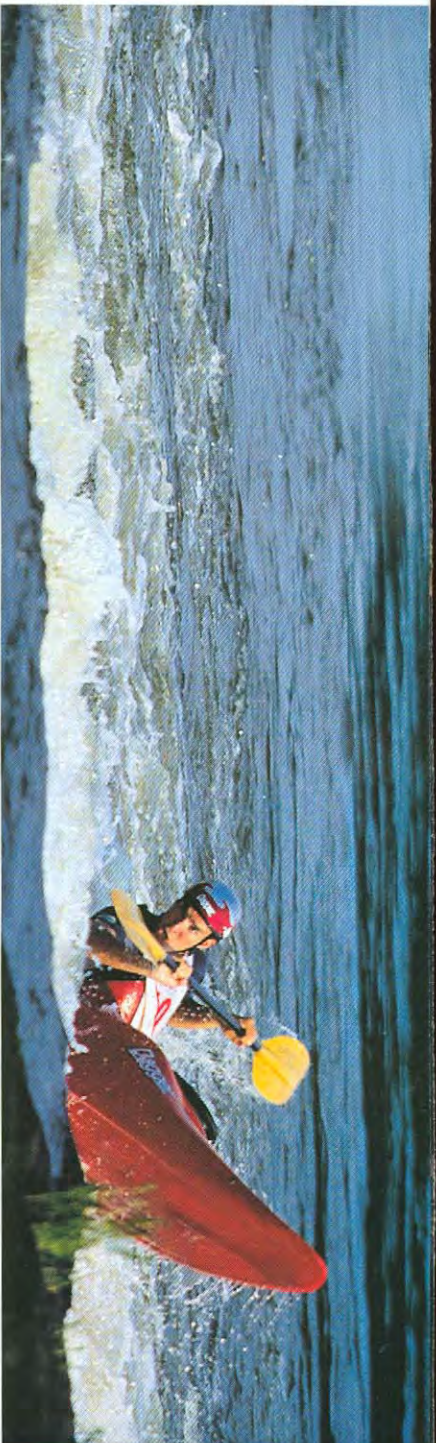

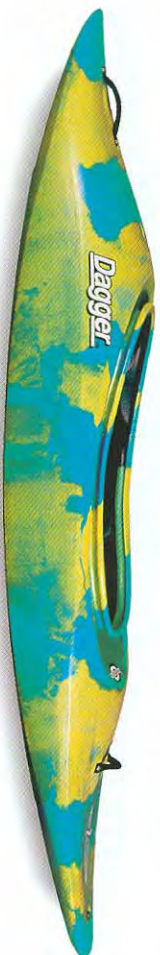

With more development and testing than any Dagger boat in history, the Medieval, Marc Lyle's inspiration and creativity, will no doubt open new horizons in freestyle kayaking. And it's not just for the experts. The Medieval is accessible to a wide range of skill levels and paddler sizes with a comfortable cockpit that you don't get in many freestyle kayaks. If you wanna get medieval in the hole, this is the boat for you.



Vertigo

The Vertigo, with its flat hull, roto-molded seat, and hard chines, will flat spin until you're dizzy; not to mention cartwheel, wawewheel and all the other wheels you can possibly think of. It has volume right where you need it for those hard to make retentive moves and the design to put you on top. This is the boat that helped Team D athletes paddle to numerous victories during the 1997-98 rodeo season.



Gradient

If steep is what you're after, the Gradient is what you need. This is the ultimate creek boat for those runs that make your stomach drop as fast as the river. As usual, we have put all of our expertise and Team D development into this boat, and it shows. Recessed deck area for a throw rope, bow and stern broach pins, roto-molded I-beam wall, non-trip chines and radical rocker for those tight moves and micro-eddies: all part of Dagger's creeking phenomenon. The Gradient's short length, high volume and fast acceleration make this boat ideal for extreme fun in extreme conditions.

Infrared

Small enough to make even 90 lb. weaklings feel powerful, the river running Infrared is made to play. A lot like its larger counterpart, the Redline, the Infrared gives smaller paddlers the same comfort with beveled chines and a planing hull that is sure to play a role in pioneering new freestyle moves. "The Infrared's got everything good about the Redline scaled down for smaller folks," Marc Lyle notes. "Don't forget the ridges for your toes; they help solve the problem of getting feet into a smaller boat, plus they flatten out the bow deck, facilitating deliberate movement in the hole."



Redline

The Redline is the next step up on the food chain from the legendary RPM. Smooth contours, squirtable ends and high performance volume distribution meld with a hull that's easy to handle. The Redline has ample knee and foot room, beveled chines and a planing hull that spins where the RPM has never spun before. The slicey, well-balanced ends of the Redline let you show off the latest freestyle moves without sacrificing river-running capacity. "People think that to pull off the hottest stuff, you have to give up speed and tracking. The Redline shatters that myth. This boat is the tool for all the freestyle moves you thought were only available in a park and play kayak." (Marc Lyle)

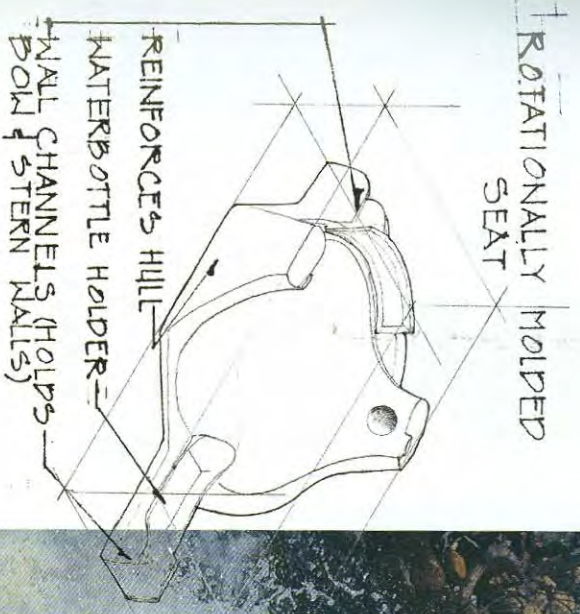
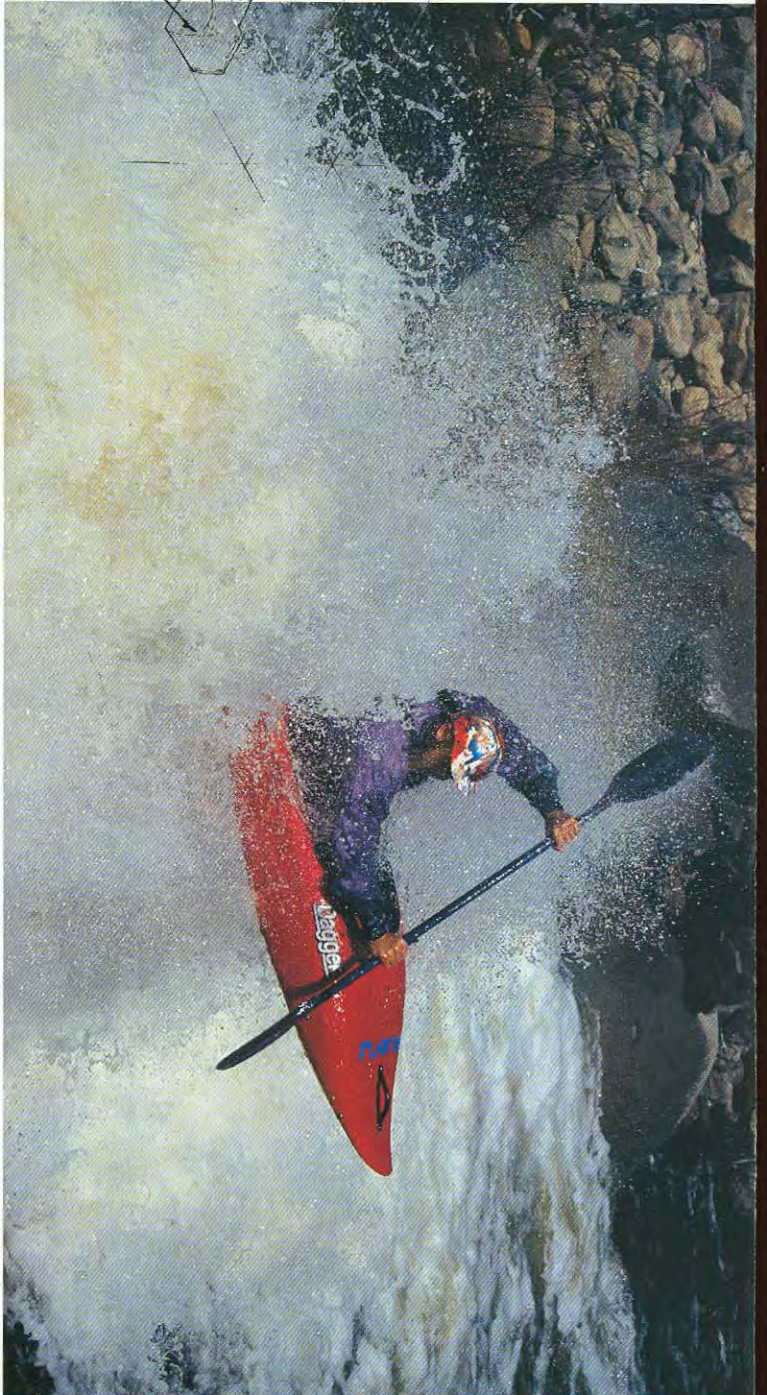

RPM MAX

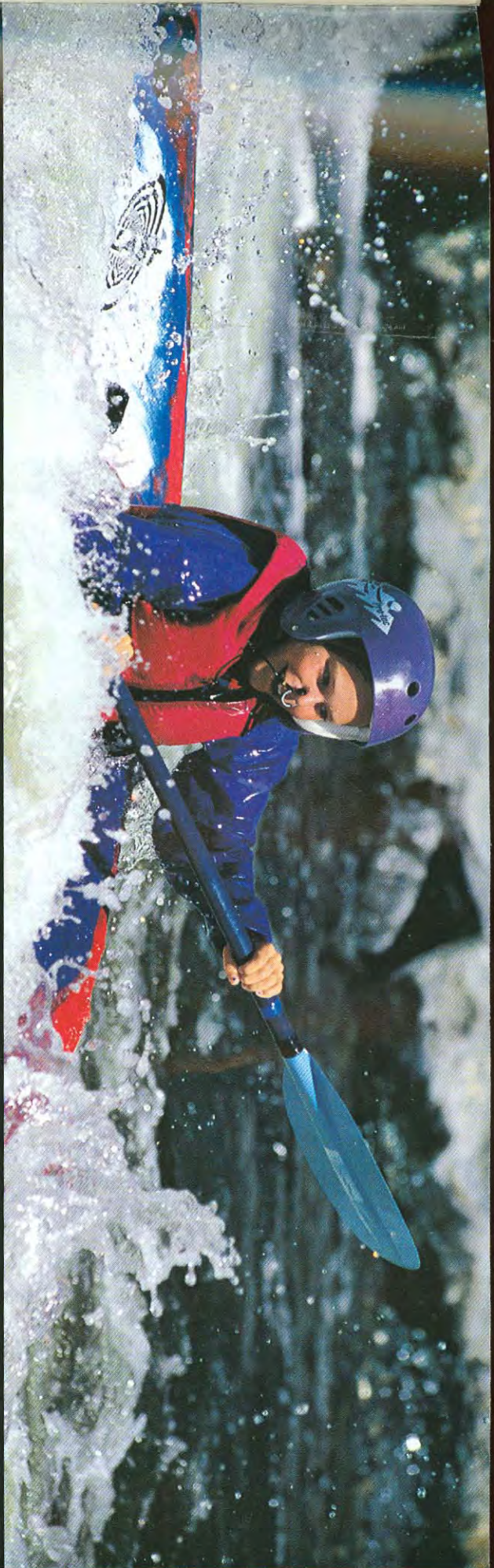

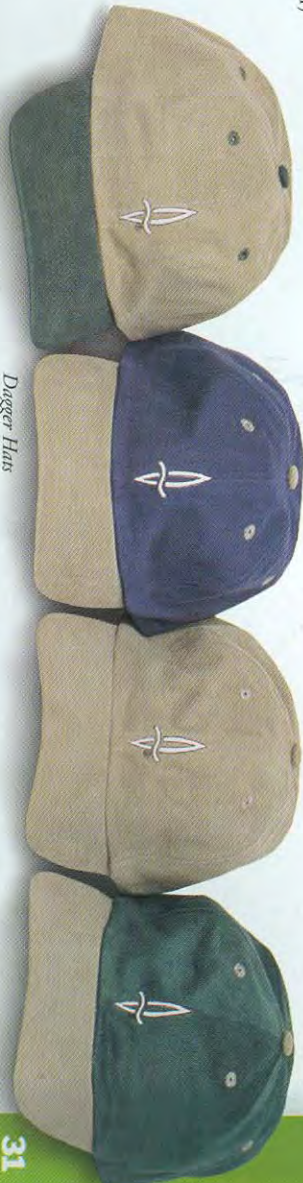
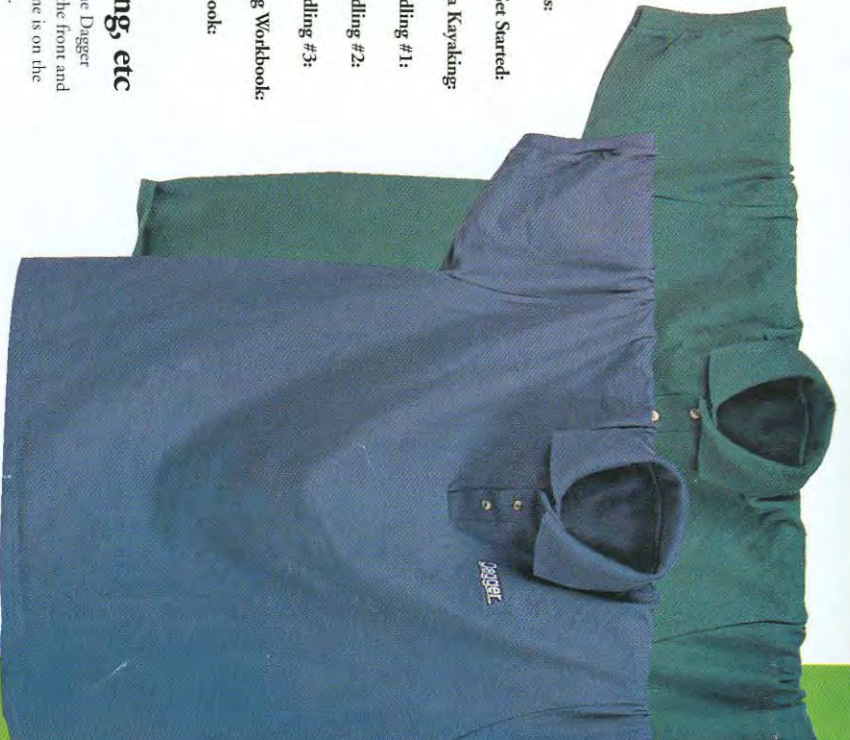
