WHAT IS A DIHEDRAL? FIBERGLASS, GRAPHITE OR WOOD?



Here's how it looks, end on: Stroke direction

Each material has distinct advantages. Fiberglass is durable and light, with just enough flex to give the paddle a great feel in the water. Moderately priced.

It's easier on your hands. Confident bracing, with less tendency to dive. Our dihedralis also have great power on a back stroke.

WHY AN ASYMMETRICAL BLADE SHAPE?

Touring kayakers keep the paddle fairly horizontal as they go. The asymmetrical shape lets them get more blade in the water for a quick, smooth, powerful stroke.

Graphite is slightly stronger, stiffer and lighter than fiberglass. Lighter blades yield a reduced swing weight. The choice for extended trips, and any time weight or fatigue is a concern.

Wood paddles are beautiful, with a lively, comfortable flex. Wooden shafts feel warmer than fiberglass or aluminum, a plus in cold weather.

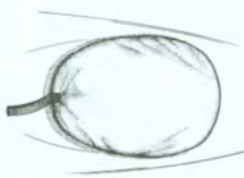

The smooth rubber skin of these seals grabs your skirt tunnel and wrists to keep out water.
