So instead of just mocho moving that wave, you can catch it, and then destroy it. But wait, there's more. With the addition of our RnCCore™ hip pods, a Precision adjustable seat, thigh braces and Camlock™ backband, you'll be more comfortable than you've ever been. You're welcome.

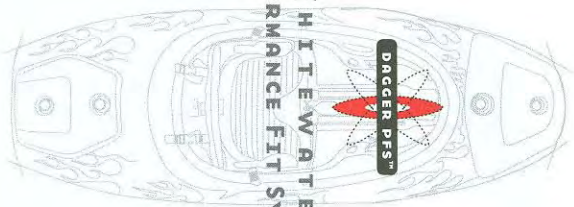
Camlock™ Adjustable Backband
Developed for Dagger Kayaks, this backband combines solid boot control with easy adjustability and extreme comfort. Cam buckles are recessed into the thigh braces for quick adjustment from the cockpit. Non-slip webbing is routed from the buckles to both sides of the backband and elastic straps keep it firmly in place.

A revolutionary inflatable air bladder inside each hip pad combines never-before-seen comfort, customization, and control. To inflate, squeeze the hand pump a few times. To deflate, push the button. Welded seams and a protective, flexible outer layer ensure long-term durability.

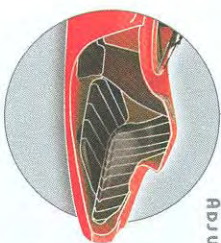

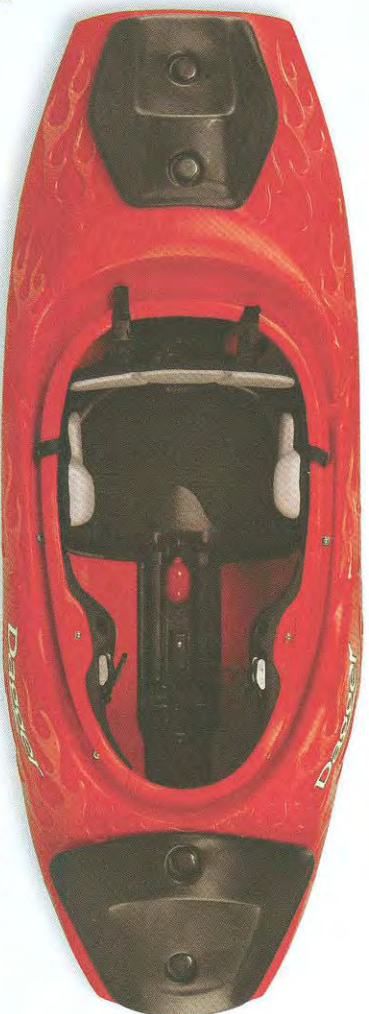

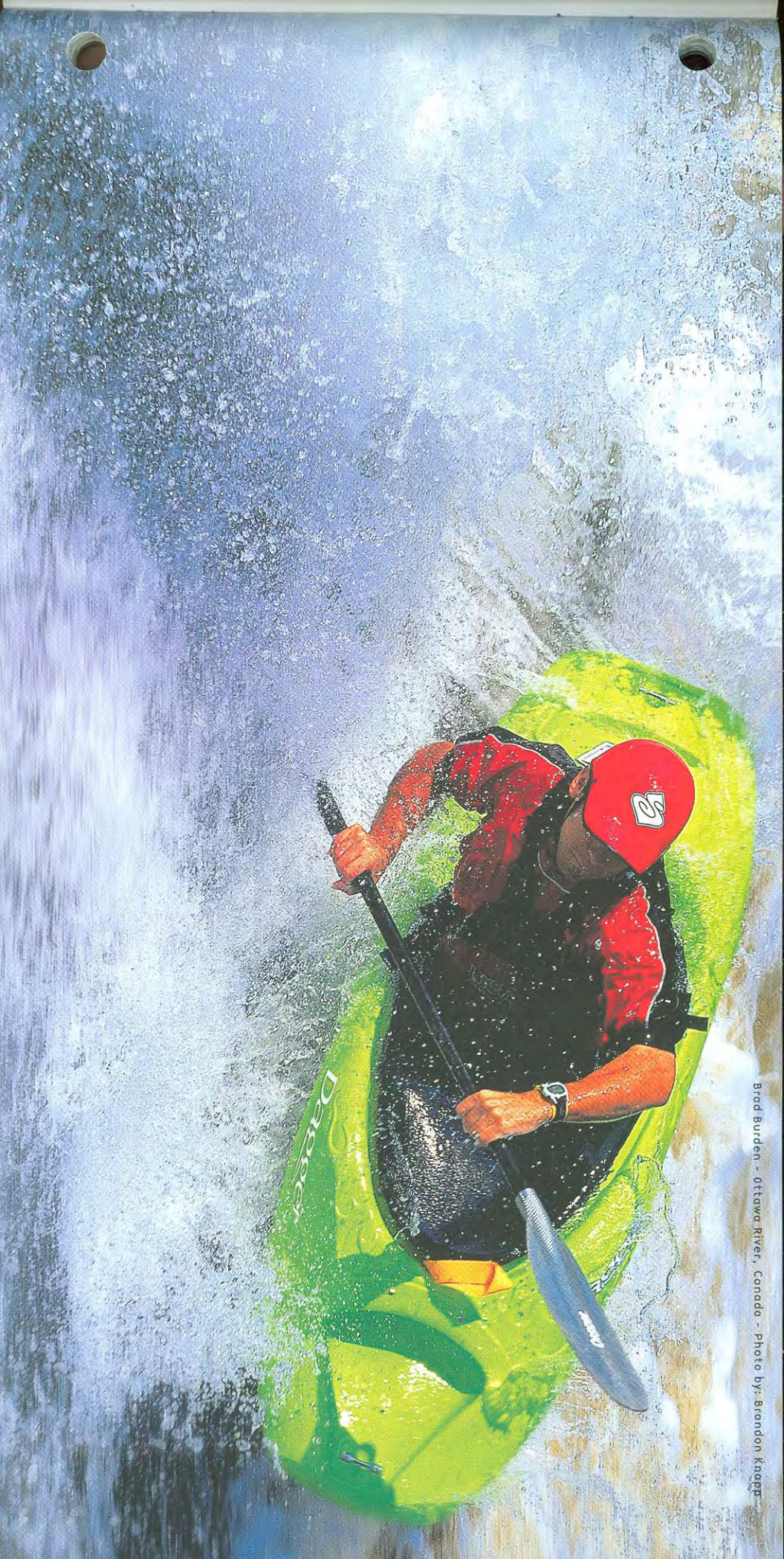
