1 PRECISION ADJUSTABLE SEAT



JUST WHAT IT SAYS IT IS, PRECISE AND ADJUSTABLE. THE SEAT COMES HELD IN PLACE BY A DEPENDABLE PLASTIC-COVERED NUT ON EACH SIDE. WITH A FEW QUICK FLICKS OF THE WRIST, IT QUICKLY (AND TOOL-FREELY) ADJUSTS FOR THREE INCHES OF TRIM AND FIT CUSTOMIZATION.

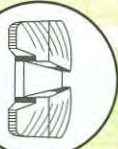
2 PRECISION ADJUSTABLE THIGH BRACES

OUR THIGH BRACES OFFER TWO INCHES OF FORE AND AFT ADJUSTMENT AND ARE JUST AS STIFF AS THEIR NON-ADJUSTABLE COUNTERPARTS. CRUCIAL, BUT OFTEN OVERLOOKED, GOOD THIGH BRACES KEEP YOU IN YOUR BOAT WHEN YOU WANT TO BE IN IT AND LET YOU OUT QUICKLY AND EASILY WHEN YOU DON'T. WE FEEL OURS ARE THE BEST — AGGRESSIVE ENOUGH TO MAXIMIZE PERFORMANCE, BUT SHAPED TO ALLOW EASY ENTRY AND EXIT, AND COMFORT? YOU'VE GOTTA FEEL IT TO BELIEVE IT.

3 CLUTCH OUTFITTING

NEVER HAS A KAYAK OUTFITTING SYSTEM COMBINED SUCH SIMPLICITY WITH SUCH COMFORT AND PERFORMANCE. ZONE IN WITH THE PROVIDED SHIMS AND PADS, THROW IN AN HOUR WITH A BREAD KNIFE AND SOME SANDPAPER (INCLUDED) AND IT'S COCKPIT Nirvana. THE FINELY SCULPTED HIP PADS, TEXTURED SEAT PAD AND THIGH BOOSTER LOCK YOU IN, AND A ROOMY COCKPIT AND NON-RESTRICTIVE THIGH BRACES LET YOU OUT WHEN THE NEED ARISES. FUNCTION, COMFORT, SIMPLICITY AND SAFETY. THAT PRETTY MUCH SAYS IT.

Because the paddler and boat act as a single unit, whitewater performance relies as much on a kayak's interior design as it does on its exterior. Few realize this like Dagger. We take the integration of advanced comfort and technical features very seriously, as you'll notice by those highlighted here.



PRESSURE PLATE
Segmented for easy adjustment, tapered for a perfect fit and specially cut to interlock with your bow wall. In short, it fits great with minimal adjustment and stays securely in the boat, whether you do or not.



SECURITY BAR
Made of stainless steel, attached with bulky tamper-resistant screws and mounted in a deep recess to fit bulky cable locks, it ensures that your boat will remain your boat. It also serves as a perfect attachment point for rescue carabiners.
